  - (2) When attendance/participation to the activity is related to performance of job functions or related to the practice of his/her profession, or the Learning and Development Intervention (LDI) is identified in the employee’s Learning and Development Plan (LDP); and
  - (3) **Subject to the office’s availability of funds.**
- B. **Official Time** when the DOH employee (whether presenter/discussant, facilitator, moderator, panelist, or participant) is duly funded through sponsorships by development partners or local partners in health. For participants, the activity should be relevant to the performance of job functions or related to the practice of his/her profession, and the LDI is identified in the employee’s LDP.

Additionally, attendees must be authorized by their respective Directors or office heads, through an appropriate Personnel Order.

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





**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR**

**TO :** DIRECTORS OF CENTERS FOR HEALTH DEVELOPMENT (CHDs), MINISTER OF HEALTH - BANGSAMORO AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM MINDANAO (MOH-BARMM), TRAINING SPECIALISTS, AND OTHER CONCERNED

**SUBJECT :** Commission on Elections (COMELEC) Resolution No. 10999 Entitled “Calendar of Activities and Periods of Certain Prohibited Acts in Connection with the May 12, 2025 National and Local Elections (NLE), and BARMM Parliamentary Elections”

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Attached for your information and guidance is the Resolution No. 10999 promulgated by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) last May 24, 2024 entitled “Calendar of Activities and Periods of Certain Prohibited Acts in Connection with the May 12, 2025 National and Local Elections (NLE), and BARMM Parliamentary Elections”.

As stated in Resolution No. 10999, starting **January 12, 2025 until June 11, 2025**, the transfer or detail of officers and employees in the civil service are prohibited. In addition, starting **March 28, 2025 until May 11, 2025**, the appointment or hiring of new employees, creation or filling up of new positions, promotions or giving salary increases, and remuneration or privilege are prohibited.

Pursuant to the above resolution, we hereby request the CHDs and MOH-BARMM to file a **Request for Exemption** under the National Health Workforce Support System (NHWSS) to the office of the Regional Election Director in the respective region. Kindly coordinate with the COMELEC in regional offices on the process and procedural requirements on the filing of the said request.




