Request for 2026 PBU application forms: Starting May 6, 2026

Application Period: June 1-15, 2026

Announcement of Eligibility: July 20, 2026

General Instructions for completing the application form:

- Please print all entries clearly in UPPER CASE (CAPITAL LETTERS) on the application form.
- Please use BLUE colored ink for all the signatures.
- Ensure all required information is filled out completely.
- Arrange your documents in the order listed below before submission.

Documentary Requirements: Please check off each item to ensure your application is complete prior to submission:

- Printed copy of duly accomplished and notarized application form with 2x2 photo.
- Digital copy of duly accomplished and notarized application form with 2x2 photo (PDF File).
- Digital copy of the USP Fellowship Training Committee Clearance form (jpeg format).
- Certificate of Good Standing issued by the National office of the Philippine College of Radiology (jpeg format)
- Digital copy of PRC ID (jpeg format). *Note: The license must remain valid throughout the entire duration of the examination*
- Digital Recent 2x2 photo (jpeg format).
- Digital copy of Proof of Payment (jpeg format).

Payment Instructions:

- Application fee deposit slip with applicant name (*jpeg format*)
 - Application Fee: 7, 500 pesos
 - Processing Fee: 500 pesos (*non-refundable*)
 - Examination Fee: 7,000 pesos
